

IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT INFORMATION FOR LBCC STUDENTS

Long Beach City College contracts with the Long Beach Police Department (LBPD) to provide protective services on the Liberal Arts and Pacific Coast campuses. The LBCC police officers wear either dark blue or green uniforms with LBPD patches. The LBPD is not an arm of the immigration authority and does not perform immigration duties. LBPD is dedicated to ensuring the safety of our entire community.



After consultation among the LBCC administration and LBCC police officers, we have identified the following procedures for students to use if they come into contact with Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE).



If you see a federal ICE agent or other federal official on campus, immediately contact LBCC's Office of the Superintendent-President at (562) 938-4559 or Public Safety at (562) 938-4910.



If any federal ICE agent or other federal official approaches you on campus, immediately contact LBCC's Office of the Superintendent-President at (562) 938-4559 or Public Safety at (562) 938-4910.



LBCC Police officers are authorized and prepared to assist our students and employees if a federal ICE agent or other federal official appears on campus. They will respond immediately to all calls.



Upon determination that ICE has made contact with any student or employee on campus, the College will provide them with the resources available to support them in dealing with ICE officials.
